Key Dates:

September 16 – Students can start submitting videos!

October 14 – Video Submission deadline.

Week of October 21 – Archdiocese of Omaha Catholic Schools will recognize the winner!

December 31 – Deadline for the student(s) to complete their project

Video Submissions:

- Video submissions must be sent to shinealightcontest@gmail.com by October 14th Video submissions must not exceed 2 minutes.
- In addition to the video attachment or link, submissions must include the following in the body of the email:
 - Students first & last name
 - The school they attend
 - Their grade level
 - A phone number where they can be reached
 - A brief explanation of their submission

The winning submission!

A winner will be announced the week of October 21st. The winner(s) will have until December 31st to execute their campaign.

The student will submit a list of materials needed for their campaign, costing up to \$1,000, which will be delivered to the student's school.

The following is required of the winner:

- Submit pictures/videos showing the preparation and execution of campaign
- Submit a written summary and reflection on the contest and their campaign
- Agree to do interviews with media between October 1st and January 15th

*The student will receive their \$200 Amazon gift card when proof of performance pictures/videos & written summary are submitted.
